English

This term we have planned a range of exciting English activities. We are starting the term off looking at fables and then move on to looking at traditional stories from other cultures. Receptions will be looking at polar regions and chinese new year.

Maths



This term we will be focusing on place value. Reception children will be learning to use Rekenreks to understand numbers to 10 and build a greater understanding. They will be focusing on subsidising numbers. Year 1 will be investigating numbers to 50 and developing their place value skills using a numberline. Yr 2 will be working on building their understanding of tens and ones and how to partition numbers to 100. This term they will look at working with money.

History and Science

In History we are learning about the greatest inventors; children will be looking at The Wright brothers and the Rainhill trials on the trains. We will be looking at how these inventions have impacted our lives today

In science this term we are looking at everyday materials. Children will think about asking questions about the properties of materials and how they can be used. Children will be encouraged to use scientific words like transparent, opaque, absorbent.

P.E. and Games - Outdoor P.E. will be taught on a Friday. We also ask that earrings are not worn on these days and long hair is tied back. Children will be covering tennis this term.



Homework

Reading at home is beneficial to helping your child make progress. Please note in your child's diary when he/she has read. EYFS uploading any of the reading activities onto Tapestry would be fantastic. Some children have been able to tick lots of stars off in the reading challenge last term.

KS1 Spellings- The children will receive spellings on a Monday and be tested the following Monday. Knowledge organisers are available to read through on the school website in the Limeclass section. Children will bring home a book with some maths learning linked to what they are covering at school.
